3W 3mm (3W) Wood Edge Stain

Please check top shape for availability.
Also note that 3mm wood edges add 2-4 weeks to the standard leadtime.

TableXpress

Wood edged tops are not available on our TableXpress Quickship Program.

Care & Maintenance

Clean all surfaces with water-dampened soft cloth in the direction of the grain. Quickly buff dry.
Immediately remove any liquids that come in contact with the wood surfaces using a blotting action to absorb the liquid. Lift objects to move them. Never pull them across the finished surface.
Avoid exposing furniture to extreme heat and cold or to wide humidity variances. Avoid exposing furniture to strong sunlight. Exposure to sunlight over time will cause finish variation. Do not use soaps, commercial cleaners or harsh solvents as they will cause finish deterioration. If using a protective glass top, place spacer pads under the glass top to allow the wood to breathe.

Folding T-bases and TT-bases

Rectangular, racetrack, and some round tables fold for easy storage. These tables are noted in the pricer by an "FD" at the end of the model number.

Standard Folding

Racetrack and rectangular tables 60" and longer use two standard folding mechanisms. Bases fold toward each other and end up toe-to-toe for a total thickness of 4.75" per table.

Short Folding

All round tables and any rectangular tables 48" long or less use a short fold mechanism. Bases fold one over the other for a total thickness of 6.75" per table.

Seating capacities

General Guidelines for Seating Capacities

- Allow about 30"/person
- Allow 48" for aisles between tables. ADA has 36" min.
- Allow 96"-120" between presenter and front row.
- Rooms with only one entrance are restricted to accommodate a maximum of 50 people (per fire code).
- Space required for single wheelchair passage is 36" min. and 60" min. for double wheelchair.
- Space required to turn a wheelchair is 60" dia.
- Newer wheelchair arms are designed to fit under standard 29"h tables (older models require an extra 2.5" of clearance)
- ADA Minimum table depth of 24".
- Ganging Wedges are not recommended for seating if top is not supported by a base.
- Capacities are based upon a 30" minimum width per seat. This chart is only a guideline which can vary based upon seating design and table layout.
